When and Where

All graduation weekend events will take place at:

Rehearsal – Friday, June 5, 2025, 7:00 P.M.

The Graduate and at least one parent are required to attend the rehearsal in order to ensure a smooth-running ceremony.

Graduation Ceremony – Saturday, June 6, 2025, 10:30 A.M.

Doors open at 10am

Reception - Immediately after the Ceremony

Guests - Due to venue capacity, we ask families to limit their guest list to approximately 8-10 people per graduate

We welcome:

- Grandparents and extended family
- Close friends, mentors, and community members
- Anyone who has played a significant role in your graduate's life—such as a coach, pastor, teacher, neighbor, or family friend
- Younger siblings and children (with adult supervision)

Event Fees and Information

We would love to keep costs down - this is the highest amount you would have to pay. We will do everything we can to give you the best return for your dollars.

Event Cost/Graduate - \$150.00

- **\$50 deposit** and registration form due February 1, 2026
- Remainder Due April 6, 2026
- Both to be paid via Sign-up Genius only using links which will be sent after registration form is completed, and again in the spring.
- **Late Fee Policy:** Payments not received by the stated deadline will incur a **10% late fee**.

Your fee will cover the following:

- A Beautiful Church Venue for rehearsal, ceremony and reception
- Decorations
- Photography and videography
- Printed programs and ceremony materials
- A Personalized Certificate of Participation
- A Senior slideshow and graduate bios
- Musicians
- A Reception with light refreshments

You will need to provide:

- A cap, gown and tassel (bought or borrowed through HV LEAH only)
- Graduate Profile Video, Headshot, 3-5 digital photos and short written bio
- A personalized parent speech for your graduate

* Further information about these items will be distributed separately after registration.

Diploma- Hudson Valley LEAH does not issue diplomas. It is the parent obligation to request a letter of substantial equivalence from the school district on behalf of their child.

Graduates

- Please abide by the HVLEAH Dress Code and Code of Conduct

- Will wear the designated cap, gown, and tassel
- May decorate their caps with respectful, creative designs
- Should wear appropriate attire under the gown—comfortable, modest, and ceremony-ready.
 - dress shirt/slacks
 - blouse/skirt/slacks/dresses
 - coordinated separates
- Avoid bulky layers or items that interfere with gown fit
- Clean, neat shoes appropriate for such an event

Families & Guests

- Please choose attire that is neat, modest, and respectful of a multi-denominational, family-friendly environment
 - Business casual or dressy casual is appropriate
 - Avoid clothing with distracting graphics, slogans, or excessive formality (e.g., tuxedos or ball gowns)
